1. (20 pts.) A heart defibrillator delivers 400 J of energy by charging a capacitor to 10,000 Volts and then discharging it rapidly (in 0.01 s) to deliver a quick "jolt". What is the capacitance of the capacitor?

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$$U = \frac{1}{2}CV^{2}$$

$$C = \frac{2U}{V^{2}} = \frac{2(400J)}{(10,060V)^{2}} = \frac{8\times10^{-6}F}{}$$
